BACKGROUND INFORMATION

The California Association of Student Leaders (CASL) is a student-led, not-for-profit organization. CASL provides a statewide network for students to facilitate the development of ethical and responsible servant leaders. The initiative is to equip and empower students to be influential leaders of the world through local, regional, and statewide conferences.

There will be approximately 7 - 12 Truckee High School students participating. The students will depart Truckee High School on/or about April 14, 2022, to the Santa Clara Convention Center and return on April 17, 2022. All students will stay on-site with the hotel attached to the conference center.

Truckee High School student leaders will learn and participate in various workshops that will be offered. These workshops range from event planning, personal time management, and staying motivated and dedicated in the most trying times.

After the conference, students will present their lessons to the Leadership Class and the administration. These lessons will be used to assist Truckee High School to run classes better and to continue to build a positive student culture.
