Program Dates: June 23 - July 18

- 4 weeks, 4 hours a day: at Kings Beach and Truckee El

Serving rising 1st, 2nd, 3rd graders in the ELOP Program

- 20 per class

Staffing:

- 3 Certificated teachers per site
 - 1 Instructional Aide per site
 - Administrator for Lakeside
 - Admin Assistant-District Wide
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AIM High



Program Dates: June 30 - August 1

- 5 weeks, 6 hours a day

Serving rising 6th, 7th, 8th graders at Kings Beach

Contracted out with AIM High

Goal is to serve 90 students, currently have 100 applications!



TK Summer Bridge

Program Dates: July 21 - August 1

- 2 weeks, 4 hours a day

Kings Beach and Truckee El

Drop off at ELOP, teacher picks up for program and then brings back

Staffing:

- 1 TK Teacher at each site
- 1 TK Instructional aide for each classroom
- 1 TK Instructional Aide for the bus

Introduce TK learners to early skills, social-emotional opportunities, and play-based learning.

ESY (Extended School Year)



ESY is a special education program with services that assist students in working towards their IEP goals in order to prevent regression of skills due to an extended break.

- Program Dates: June 25 - July 23
- 4 hours per day for a minimum of 20 days
- TTUSD provides transportation, breakfast, and lunch
- Programs are located at Truckee Elementary and Truckee High School

Students focus on:

- Maintaining academic, functional, life, and behavior skills
- Credit recovery
- Having Summer Fun!
