BACKGROUND INFORMATION

National Immunization Month was established to encourage people of all ages to make sure they are up to date on the vaccines recommended for them. Communities use the month of August each year to raise awareness about the important role vaccines play in preventing serious, sometimes deadly, diseases. New California vaccine law went into effect on July 1 2016; eliminating the option for the Personal Belief Exemption. Tahoe Truckee Unified School District believes that the physical, social and emotional well-being of students results from a partnership between families, the school staff, and the community.
