## **BACKGROUND INFORMATION**

High School Students will enjoy exploring Spanish and Latin American literature from the medieval to the 21st century. This course delves into significant works, examining their historical, cultural, and social contexts to gain deeper insights into their meanings.

Students will read 38 works, including Medieval and Golden Age Masterpieces, 19th—and 20th-century Gems, and Contemporary Latin American Voices.
