## **BACKGROUND INFORMATION**

The Tahoe Truckee Unified School District 2025 summer program offers a comprehensive and inclusive range of options for students across various grade levels and needs. This includes programs for incoming Transitional Kindergarten students, elementary, middle, and high school students (for credit recovery).

The elementary summer program will feature the Extended Learning Opportunities Program, in partnership with the Boys and Girls Club of North Lake Tahoe. Aim High will provide engaging and educational experiences for rising middle school students and 9th graders.

Additionally, TTUSD will offer a TK Bridge Camp to support incoming TK students' transition from preschool to kindergarten in a nurturing environment. High school students can participate in a credit recovery program to make up missed credits and maintain their academic progress.

Our goal is to deliver high-quality summer programs that support student success, encourage personal growth, and cultivate a passion for learning.
