Approve Resolution No. 11-2021-2022 - Authorize Superintendent to Sign Application for Continued Funding for the California State Preschool Program

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

The Tahoe Truckee Unified School District is awarded a contract from the California Department of Education each year to provide two half-day State Preschool programs for 48 children from income eligible families. The program is located at Truckee Elementary and Cindy Maciel is the program manager. Jeff Santos and the Student Services Division has direct oversight of the program. The majority of the students enrolled feed into Truckee Elementary as TK or K students and Valarie Simpson appreciates the program's contribution to school readiness. The District's Special Education Preschool is also located at Truckee Elementary and the State Preschool provides onsite opportunities for mainstreaming with age appropriate peers.

Beginning this year, the school board is required to pass a resolution to authorize the Superintendent Chief Learning Officer to sign the application for continued funding in 2022-2023. The amount of funding will be determined upon review of the application.
