BACKGROUND INFORMATION

On January 1, 2014, the California Assessment of Student Performance and Progress (CAASPP) System was established. The primary purpose of the CAASPP System is to assist teachers, administrators, students, and parents by promoting high-quality teaching and learning through various assessment approaches and item types. The results identify where students are doing well or where they need more help. This information helps teachers better support learning in the classroom, and families can better support learning at home.

Last spring, TTUSD students in grades 3 - 8 and 11 took the CAASPP tests for English Language Arts (ELA) and Math. This presentation provides an overview of how TTUSD students performed on the ELA and Math CAASPP in the spring of 2022.
